### **DUTCH CONSULATE OFFICIALLY RECOGNIZES LITTLE CHUTE WINDMILL PROJECT**

LITTLE CHUTE, WI (November 15, 2006) – In honor of Dutch-American Heritage Day on November 16 the Consulate General of The Kingdom of The Netherlands in Chicago has officially recognized the Little Chute Windmill Project. This recognition comes as an official declaration from the Dutch Consulate General Willem Schiff. The declaration states, “On the occasion of Dutch-American Heritage Day, the Consulate General of The Kingdom of The Netherlands is pleased to be made aware of the Little Chute Windmill Project. The Consulate General acknowledges the project’s importance for underlining Dutch-American heritage in general and in particular the Dutch heritage of Little Chute, Wisconsin.”. This honor lends further legitimacy to the project and is a benefit to the efforts and goals of Little Chute Windmill, Inc. In coming years, Little Chute Windmill, Inc. plans to celebrate Dutch-American Heritage Day with festivities held at The Little Chute Windmill and Visitor Center.

Little Chute Windmill, Inc. is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization dedicated to raising \$2.3 million to build an authentic working 100 foot tall Dutch windmill in downtown Little Chute to celebrate the Dutch heritage of the area. To date, approximately \$1.5 million towards the goal has been raised. Ground breaking will likely take place in the spring of 2007.
